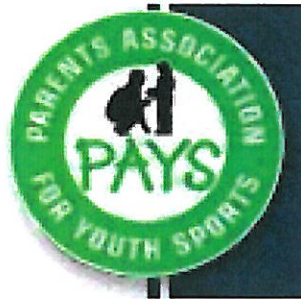


Maize Recreation Commission is Incorporating a New Program... For Parents!

The purpose of P.A.Y.S. is to educate and motivate youth league parents to create the ultimate youth sports environment aimed at making the child's experience safe, positive and meaningful! To implement this program, the MRC will REQUIRE parents of all sport participants to attend a meeting outlining the details of the P.A.Y.S. program. Meetings will be held at the Maize Recreation Office and will last approximately 45 minutes. Upon completion of the P.A.Y.S. program, you will be given a signed card that is valid for two years.
